Dr. Kaitlin Bove is Director of Bands and an Assistant Professor of Music at Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Hill, California. She also serves as Artistic Director for the Diablo Wind Symphony (part of Blue Devils Performing Arts) and on the board of California Band Directors Association. Kaitlin holds a Doctorate of Musical Arts in Wind Conducting from University of Kentucky and a Masters and Bachelors of Music in Education from the University of the Pacific. Kaitlin is founder of the And We Were Heard initiative, a volunteer organization that matches underrepresented composers of wind band and orchestral literature with ensembles, generating quality recordings of the music of diverse compositional voices. She is also co-founder of Girls Who Conduct, a mentorship program that supports gender parity on the conducting podium.
