Geoffrey Gallegos, has been a fixture in the San Francisco Bay Area music community for over 35 years. He is currently Music Director and Conductor of the Kensington (CA) Symphony Orchestra (2004), the West County Winds (2015), and the Contra Costa Chamber Orchestra (2021). Maestro Gallegos has a deep commitment to music education. Since 2001 he has been Artistic Director and Principal Conductor of the Golden Gate Philharmonic, an all-city youth string orchestra in San Francisco, and now also serves as its Executive Director. From 2001-2010, he participated in the Artist in Residence program at the Ruth Asawa School of the Arts (S.O.T.A.) in San Francisco appearing as guest conductor of the orchestra and wind ensembles. From 2007-2010, Since 2005, he has been a member of the Board of Directors of the Community Music Center in San Francisco where he began his music studies with the trumpet at the age of nine.
